Jayne Lourasch with Laborer's Home Development Corporation is coming in July to look at doing another Hilldale project. Regarding annexation, the Thamm's would like to voluntarily annex their property into city limits and Crawford is trying to figure out how to do that without creating an island. There is a preconstruction meeting on Thursday for the 2019 Street Projects. Morningside shelter house is almost complete. The gutter work has been scheduled, which will finalize that project.
