Mayor Pro-tem Loeschen read a written report from Soseman. She has had a meeting with Job Corp and attended a conference call with the Lincoln Hwy Assoc. The downtown improvement committee continues toward their goal of rebranding the City of Denison. They are also working on way finding signs, identifying outdoor dining area possibilities and new banners. The Census is at about 64% for Denison. The housing committee will be traveling to Jefferson on Wed to view Homes for Iowans.

CITY MANAGER REPORT

Crawford reported that the Notice to Bidders for the N. 20th St. project is in the paper today with bids due on Aug. 4th. Public Works cleared tree limbs along N. 20th St. today. Crawford is working on a Safe Routes to Schools grant for a route along N. 20th St. Public Works is looking at the alley east of HyVee and at 14th St. between 1st Ave S. & Broadway for a possible project. Rich Knowles has requested the speed limit on N. 10th St. be increased back to 35 mph just past Hilldale Estates. Crawford will speak with Chief Schaffer again when Schaffer is feeling up to it.
