Important

- A PERMIT IS REQUIRED BEFORE ANY WORK BEGINS.
- Except under emergency circumstances, a \$250 fine will be added for work that has been started prior to obtaining a permit. In emergency situations, permits are expected to be obtained the next business morning.
- A permit will expire if work doesn't commence within six (6) months
 of the permit date, or if work is abandoned for six (6) months.
- Permits are non-transferable; all work shall be performed by permit holder or their <u>properly licensed</u> employee(s) listed on license application.
- ALL WORK MUST BE INSPECTED.
- It is the responsibility of the permit holder to call for all inspections.
- The permit holder must be proficient in relevant codes.
- Questions should be resolved prior to installation.
- Work not approved shall be considered incomplete.
- No work shall be concealed or covered until approved by the inspector.

Mechanical & Plumbing: New Construction

Mechanical work in new construction will be included in the General Building Permit, subject to the same fee schedule as General Building Permit. A general contractor cannot perform mechanical work under a general contractor's license and must list a qualified and licensed subcontractor on the General Building Permit who will be completing the mechanical work.

Plumbing work in new construction will be included in the General Building Permit, subject to the same fee schedule as General Building Permit. A general contractor cannot perform plumbing work under a general contractor's license and must list a qualified and licensed subcontractor on the General Building Permit who will be completing the plumbing work.

Types of Work

A current mechanical license is required for the following (a hydronics license or HVAC/refrigeration license, may qualify to handle some of the following):

Heating systems include gas furnace, electric furnace, heat pumps, wall/floor/ suspended heaters, fireplaces, rooftop units, steam or water boilers, radiant heating, and other mechanical heating systems.

Cooling systems include A/C units, rooftop units, integrated wall coolers, cooling towers, refrigeration coolers and freezers, refrigerant, and other mechanical cooling systems.

Venting includes venting systems, ductwork, in-duct fans and other units, and any other air handling venting or ductwork.

A current plumbing license will be required for the following types of work: **Plumbing** includes water supply and distribution, water treatment devices, water heaters, backflow preventers, and any other water supply and distribution systems. **Sanitary Drainage** includes any sewer work between the building and City sewer lines, including repair, replacement, and hooking onto the City line.
