<p>IEDA Redevelopment Tax Credits</p> <p>https://www.iowaeda.com/redevelopment-tax-credits/</p>	<p>Annual application submittal (due September 1st); tax credits of up to 24% for qualifying costs of a brownfield project and 30% if the project meets green building requirements; tax credits of up to 12% of qualifying costs of a grayfield project and 15% if the project meets green building requirements; program capped at \$15 million per fiscal year with a maximum award per project of \$1.5 million</p>	<p>Individual, limited liability company, S corporation, non-profit, estate or trust</p>	<p>HIGH</p>
