

SPECIAL CALLED CITY COUNCIL MEETING
Tuesday, January 16, 2024
(Immediately following Regular Council Meeting held at 5 p.m.)
Council Chambers – Denison, Iowa

The special called council meeting of the City of Denison, Iowa, was held pursuant to law on the above date and hour. Mayor Soseman called the meeting to order with the following members present: Granzen, Logan, Miller, Zupp-Smith, and Curnyn by telephone.

CHIEF TREJO PRESENTED THE PD BUDGET Discussion was held on the FY 23/24 Budget. Chief Trejo presented the Police Department budget. Trejo would like to increase the budget for additional training, a school resource officer, increased wages for Police Officers, increased wage for an office admin/emergency dispatcher, increased wage for a lead dispatcher, new computers, new MDTs, and a new Chief vehicle that can be used for a mobile command center.

CHIEF SNOWGREN PRESENTED THE FD BUDGET Chief Snowgren presented the Fire Department budget. He stated the new equipment line is to replace current equipment and he reviewed the proposed stipend program. Council would like the stipend program to be separated from salaries. Snowgren reviewed the Truck Fund budget. The cash on hand will be used to purchase a new tanker.

TYLER WELLER REVIEWED THE FLOOD BUDGET Tyler Weller, Flood Control Officer, review the Flood Warning budget. He would like to purchase a skidsteer out of the bond funds.

BUILDING, DOG POUND, SENIOR CENTER AND BOULDERS BUDGETS PRESENTED Garcia and Flaherty presented the Building Department budget, Dog Pound budget, Senior Center budget, and Boulders budget. Council directed Flaherty to remove health insurance from the Boulders budget.

NEXT BUDGET WORKSHOP 1-24-2024 The next budget workshop will be on Wednesday, January 24, 2024, at 5 p.m.

There being no other business, the meeting adjourned at 8:59 p.m.
