The special called council meeting of the City of Denison, Iowa, was held pursuant to law on the above date and hour. Mayor Soseman called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. with the following members present: Curnyn, Garcia, and Miller. Absent: Granzen and Logan at 5:07 p.m.

FY 23/24 BUDGET Discussion was held on the FY 23/24 Budget. Evan Blakey, CDC Executive Director, presented their budget and audit. Their last increase was in FY 20/21.

LOGAN ARRIVED Logan arrived at 5:07 p.m.

FY 23/24 BUDGET Council reviewed the Airport budget, Parks and Rec budget, and special account budgets. Flaherty stated she would like to change Administration budget and have one-time expenses come out of Capital Improvements and add in costs for the Iowa Association of Municipal Utilities Safety Coordinator. Martens reduced the Road Use Tax budget and it is now a positive figure. Council would like Flaherty and Hanson to work with Department Directors to make cuts and then bring the reduced budget back to Council for additional direction.
