

SPECIAL CALLED CITY COUNCIL MEETING
Monday, January 9, 2023 – 5:00 p.m.
Council Chambers – Denison, Iowa

The special called council meeting of the City of Denison, Iowa, was held pursuant to law on the above date and hour. Mayor Soseman called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. with the following members present: Curnyn, Garcia, Logan, and Miller. Absent: Granzen at 5:26 p.m.

SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROJECT	Discussion was held on the Safe Routes to School project. Terry Crawford with Sundquist Engineering, presented Council the preliminary and final plans. Council is concerned with the cost increase. Crawford stated the project has been expanding and the estimates are high. The engineer fees were originally estimated at 11 percent and are now based on Sundquist Engineering fees.
IDOT PUBLIC INTEREST FINDING REQUEST	Motion by Garcia, seconded by Logan, to allow the Mayor to sign the IDOT Public Interest Finding Request. Motion carried unanimously.
PROJECT DEVELOPMENT CERTIFICATION	Motion by Logan, seconded by Garcia, to allow the Mayor to sign the Project Development Certification. Motion carried unanimously.
FY 23/24 BUDGET	Discussion was held on the FY 23/24 Budget. Flaherty stated that the budget as presented is unbalanced by \$738,408.52.
BUDGETS	Council reviewed the Police Department budget, Fire Department budget, Road Use Tax budget, and Building Department budget. No changes were made at this time.
ADDITIONAL BUDGET WORKSHOP	Discussion was held on holding an additional budget workshop. Consensus was to set it for Wednesday, January 25, 2023, at 5:00 p.m.

There being no other business, the meeting adjourned at 8:02 p.m.
