ORDINANCE CHAPTER 126 - SPECIAL EVENTS	Flaherty stated she would like Council to consider updating the ordinance. There are areas that the City does not enforce and staff has recommended changes. Council would like Flaherty to make changes and have it on a future Council meeting for discussion. Soseman recommends making a brochure with the current requirements.
WELLNESS CENTER UPDATE	Garcia stated the Wellness Center Committee should receive the YMCA proforma at their March meeting. They have raised approximately 67 percent of the fundraising for the \$18 million proposed facility. The Committee has also received a \$4.5 million Destination Iowa grant.
ARPA FUNDS	Council would like to look at different ways to spend the unallocated ARPA funds. Garica would like to see money set aside for Safety Town. Flaherty also recommends street repairs. Curnyn stated 16 th and Broadway and 4 th Avenue North need repairs and he will ask Martens to compile numbers.
FEE SCHEDULE INCREASE	Hanson stated that Flattery, Building Inspector, will present at the next Planning session.
SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING SCHEDULED	A special Council meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 28, 2023, at 5 p.m. to discuss the vacant Police Chief and vacant City Manager positions.
