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GENERAL INFORMATION

CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR DENISON, IOWA CHAPTER 122: PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, TRANSIENT MERCHANTS, AND MOBILE FOOD UNIT VENDORS (partial)

122.02 DEFINITIONS. For use in this chapter the following terms are defined:

- "PEDDLER" means any person carrying goods or merchandise who sells or offers for sale for immediate delivery such goods or merchandise from house to house or upon the public street
- "SOLICITOR" means any person who solicits or attempts to solicit from house to house or upon the public street any contribution or donation or any order for goods, services, subscriptions or merchandise to be delivered at a future date.
- 3. "TRANSIENT MERCHANT" means any person who engages in a temporary or itinerant merchandising business and in the course of such business hires, leases or occupies any building or structure whatsoever, or who operates out of a vehicle which is parked anywhere within the City limits. Temporary association with a local merchant, dealer, trader or auctioneer, or conduct of such transient business in connection with, as a part of, or in the name of any local merchant, dealer, trader or auctioneer does not exempt any person from being considered a transient merchant.
- "VENDOR" means any person who sells any consumable food, beverage or non-food item upon any publicly-owned City property to the public in the City.

122.03 LICENSE REQUIRED. Any person engaging in peddling, soliciting, vending; or in the business of a transient merchant; or food vending from a mobile food unit in the City without first obtaining a license as herein provided is in violation of this chapter. Fines for not obtaining a license are listed in the Schedule of Civil Penalties and Fees contained in the Appendix to this Code of Ordinances

122.04 APPLICATION FOR LICENSE. An application in writing shall be filed with the Clerk for a license under this chapter. Such application shall set forth the applicant's name, permanent and local address, and business address if any. The application shall also set forth the applicant's employer, if any, the employer's address, the nature of the applicant's business, the last three places of such business, a list of any vehicles used in the business and the license plate number of any such vehicles and the length of time sought to be covered by the license. At the time of application all applicants will present to the Clerk a form of identification containing the applicants photograph. All food vendors shall comply with the lowa Department of Health rules and regulations governing the sale of food for consumption on the premises.

122.05 LICENSE FEES. The fees for the issuance of a license under this chapter shall be set by resolution of the City Council and are listed in the Schedule of Civil Penalties and Fees contained in the Appendix to this Code of Ordinances.

122.06 REFUNDS. License fees are non-refundable.

122.07 TIME RESTRICTIONS.

- 1. Peddlers and Solicitors. All peddler's and solicitor's licenses shall provide that said licenses are in force and effect only between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.
- 2. Mobile Food Unit Vendors and Transient Merchants. All mobile food unit and transient merchant licenses shall provide that said licenses are in force and effect only between the hours of 6 a.m. and 10 p.m. on Sunday through Thursday, and between the hours of 6 a.m. and 2 a.m. on Friday and Saturday.

Selling from house to house or on a public street, merchandise for immediate delivery <u>between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. only.</u>

□ SOLICITOR

Selling from house to house or on a public street, donations, contributions, or orders for goods, services, subscriptions, or merchandise to be delivered at a future date between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. only.

☐ TRANSIENT MERCHANT

Engaging in a temporary business from any building or structure, or out of a vehicle parked within City limits.
